Knee Osteoarthritis Injection Therapy (KNIT) Trial



Beacon Centre for Orthopaedics are conducting research on Injection Therapy in the Management of Knee Osteoarthritis.

The KNIT trial investigates which out of three commonly used injections provide the best results for participants at 1, 3 and 12 months post injection.

Who is Eligible?

Those who have been diagnosed with osteoarthritis in one knee and are otherwise in good health.

What is Involved?

A screening assessment, receiving one of the three injections, and two short follow-up questionnaires at 1, 3 and 12 months post injection.

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
